

## **OCELLATED TURKEY**

**Worldwide Pursuit offers an all-inclusive hunt for the elusive Ocellated Turkey, located 2.5 hours from Campeche City.**

### **HUNTING SEASON**

March and April

### **TRAVEL INFORMATION**

Flights should be scheduled into Merida International Airport (MID) before 2pm on the day of arrival, where Jeff or Gabriela will greet you and escort you to our host town of Tixmucuy. You will not be overnight in a hotel near the airport, as we will take you directly to our accommodations. Tixmucuy is approximately 2.5 hours from the airport.

### **TYPICAL EXPERIENCE**

Our hunters arrive midafternoon after our short drive from the airport. You arrive with a welcome drink, a light snack or lunch, and unpacking of your personal gear. As with all our hunts, you shoot turkey targets soon after, to make sure everyone is comfortable with their gun.

Temperatures early morning are 75-80°F and rise to 90-100°F.

Our typical day starts around 4:30 am with a light breakfast of juice, coffee, snacks, fruit, and toast. Our hunters depart in 4x4 vehicles for their 1x1 hunting experience, which lasts until mid to late morning. We return to camp for an amazing traditional Mayan meal. A second outing in the afternoon begins around 2-3 pm and we hunt until dark. We wrap up each night with a custom prepared meal from our great chef and enjoy drinks around the table or in the pool.

### **HUNTING PACKAGE**

### **PACKAGE INCLUDES**

- 1 Ocellated Turkey Permit
- Ground Transportation from Campeche or Merida Airport to the hunting area and back
- 8 outings total (morning and evening hunts)
- Meals, Water, Snacks, Soft drinks, Alcohol: Beer, Wine, Tequila, Whisky (with moderation)
- Lodging with A/C, TV, Pool, and Wi-Fi
- 1 Local Guide per Hunter
- Use of Shotgun-Pump action, O/U and semi-auto with Indian Creek 12ga, 20ga, 28ga, .410ga.
- Local Chef with Gourmet Local Dishes
- Assistance with the importation of trophies.

## **WHAT TO BRING**

- Camo clothing, Cotton Pants, Cotton T-shirts, Cotton Long sleeve shirt to wear over t-shirt,
- Camo gloves, cap or hat, Net for the face, Face mask, Paliacate for the neck or towel band for the head because the humidity
- Light hiking boots, Tennis shoes & Sandals for the shower

- Small flashlight or headlamp
- Bug-Insect repellent or Thermocell
- Sunscreen
- Pocket knife
- Shorts & t-shirts
- Camera/video camera
- Personal medicine

- Non-Hunter Fee \$300 USD per day
- Cleaning, Skinning and Salting for Brockett Deer \$150
- Tips for Hunting Guides and Camp Staff
- Extra Alcohol
- Airlines Tickets
- Hotels, Transportation, Food and Lodging **before and after** hunting if necessary
- Extra trip from Merida to the lodge or lodge to Merida \$300 USD (**Depart Early after hunt**)
- Personal Expenses
- Laundry Services are available on the last day of each hunt (around \$20-\$30 USD per person)
- IF time permits, the Mayan Ruins are nearby for a day trip. **\$30 per person**
